B-QUIZ STRUCTURE

1. Sourcing Participants

- We'll focus on attracting participants through a variety of channels, such as:
 - College campus announcements and newsletters.
 - Collaborations with student clubs and organizations.
 - Social media outreach, including Instagram and LinkedIn.
 - Direct invites to students excelling in academics or extracurriculars in related fields.

2. Team Composition: - Teams of 3 OR LESS participants each.

- Round 1: Preliminary Round (Written Round)
 - Number of Questions: 20 business-related questions (one word answer).
 - Format: Written on paper.
 - Time Limit: 10 -15 minutes.
 - Scoring: Each correct answer is 1 point. No negative marking.
 - Qualifying Criteria: Top 6 teams with the highest scores move to Round 2.
 - Tie-breaker (if needed): In case of a tie, the team that made the first incorrect answer on the question list gets eliminated.
 - Round 2: On-Stage Round :-This round is divided into three sub-rounds.
- Sub-Round 1: Clockwise Q&A Round
 - Format: Simple Q&A round. Questions are asked one by one to each team in a clockwise rotation.
 - Number of Questions: 3 questions per team.
 - Scoring: +10 points for a correct answer, no negative marking.
 - Pass Rule: If a team doesn't answer correctly, the question can be passed to the next team for 5 points.

• Sub-Round 2: Buzzer Round

- Format: Teams must hit the buzzer to answer.
- Number of Questions: 10 questions.
- Scoring: +10 points for a correct answer, -5 points for an incorrect answer.
- Tie-breaker (if needed): In case two teams hit the buzzer at the same time, the team that finishes their answer first gets priority.

• Sub-Round 3: Rapid Fire Round

- Format: All teams receive a sheet of paper and answer 10 quick questions within 50 seconds.
- Number of Questions: 10 questions (short answers or MCQs).
- Scoring: Each correct answer is worth 1 point. No negative marking.

WINNER WILL BE THE HIGHEST SCORER OF COMBINED ON STAGE ROUNDS (ALL 3 SUB

ROUNDS)

- Tie-Breaker Round (if needed)
 - Format: Sudden death-style Q&A.
 - Number of Questions: One question at a time.
 - Rules: Teams answer one by one; the first incorrect answer eliminates the team. The round continues until a clear winner is identified.
