The maximum time limit for each performance is 10 minutes only.

7. Judging Criteria:

- Evaluation will be based on the following:
- Synchronization: How well the group is coordinated.
- Choreography: Creativity and innovation in dance moves and formation transitions.
- Energy: Overall energy and enthusiasm throughout the performance.
- Expression: Clarity of emotions and expressions.
- Costume and Stage Presence: Appropriateness and visual appeal of the costumes, as well as stage confidence.
- Audience Engagement: Ability to connect and captivate the audience.
