GUIDELINES FOR NUKKAD NATAK

1. Objective

The Nukkad Natak competition at UDBHAV 2025 aims to revive and promote traditional street theatre as a medium of social awareness, creativity, and entertainment. This platform enables participants to express themselves through impactful performances while addressing societal issues.

2. Registration

3. Team Composition

• Each team must consist of 5-15 members.

4. Event Format

- Theme: Environmental Awareness| Social Issues | Education and Youth | Civic Responsibilities | Cultural Heritage | Technology and Society | Health and Wellness
- Performance Time: Each team will have 8–12 minutes to perform.
- Setup Time: A maximum of 2 minutes is allowed for stage setup.
- Venue: Open-air stage or designated street area on campus.

5. Judging Parameters

- Relevance to Theme: Connection to the given theme and depth of interpretation.
- Creativity and Innovation: Novelty in script, direction, and execution.
- Impact: Ability to engage the audience and convey the intended message.
- Acting Skills: Coordination, dialogue delivery, and overall performance.
- Use of Props: Effective and creative use of minimal props.
- Audience Engagement: Interaction and connection with the crowd.

6. Rules and Regulations

- Scripts must be original and align with the theme.
- Performances must avoid any content deemed offensive, political, or controversial.
- Teams are responsible for their props, costumes, and music.
- Use of any prerecorded soundtracks is prohibited.
- The language of performance can be Hindi or any Indian regional language (with prior submission of a translated script).
- All team members must be present one hour before the scheduled performance.
- The decision of the judging panel is final and binding.

7. Prizes and Certificates

- Cash prizes will be awarded to the top teams.
 1st Prize-Rs5000 (Further Prizes Depend on the number of registrations)
- All participants will receive certificates of participation.
