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ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The **2nd World Management Conference (WMC)** will be held on **June 27, 2025** in virtual mode. **WMC 2025** aims to bring together academics, research scholars, executives, entrepreneurs, and policymakers for an exchange of ideas on the theme of **Business Resilience**.

In the face of geopolitical instability, volatile commodity markets, rising inflation, an increasing probability of more frequent and severe climate disasters, global health crises, and major shifts in consumer and industrial demand, business leaders anticipate long-term pressure on their business models, and as a consequence, greater need for resilience¹. Resilience is the ability to withstand unpredictable threats or change, continuously adapt for growth, emerge stronger, and thrive in a hostile environment. McKinsey & Company identifies six dimensions of resilience: financial, operational, technological, organizational, reputational, and business-model resilience². Traditional management approaches with their focus on (short-term) financial performance management and designing and executing stable plans, limit firms' ability to design for, measure, and manage resilience for resilience is a property of systems and requires a multi-timescale perspective³.

The conference aims to focus deliberations on the theme of business resilience, to collate and disseminate the latest research and perspectives far and wide. We invite original, unpublished research work related to the theme across all disciplines of management based on qualitative, quantitative, or mixed-method approaches in the form of research papers and case studies.

- Abstracts/proposals and full papers are to be submitted without author details to enable blind review; author details (name, affiliation, email address, phone number, and corresponding author) are to be submitted in a separate file.
- Abstracts/proposals and full papers are to be submitted in the .docx format (MS Word), conforming to the following guidelines:
 - Word Limit:
 - Abstract/Proposal: 250 – 300
 - Full Paper: 3,000 – 5,000
 - Font: Times New Roman
 - Font Size (Text): 12
 - Font Size (End Notes): 10
 - Line Spacing: 1.5
 - Text Alignment: Justified
 - References: APA 7 Style
- Only full papers accepted and presented will be considered for the Best Paper Awards.
- Abstracts/proposals and full papers are to be submitted through the submission link on the conference webpage.
- An edited book of the full papers accepted and presented at the conference will be published with an ISBN.
